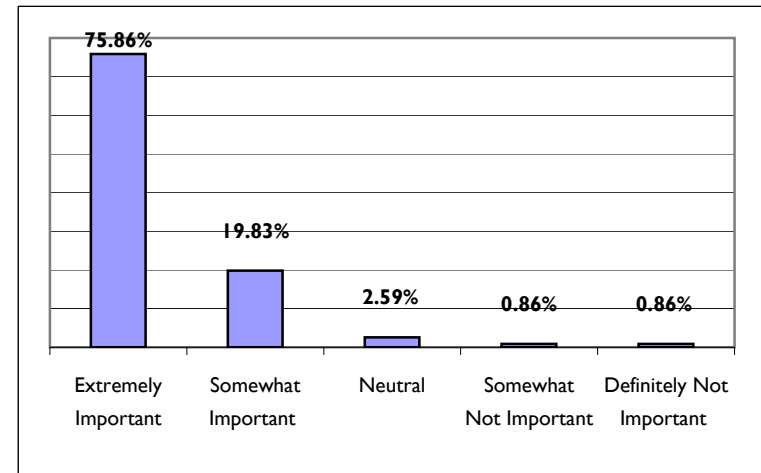


Urban Design Element

(multiple choice)

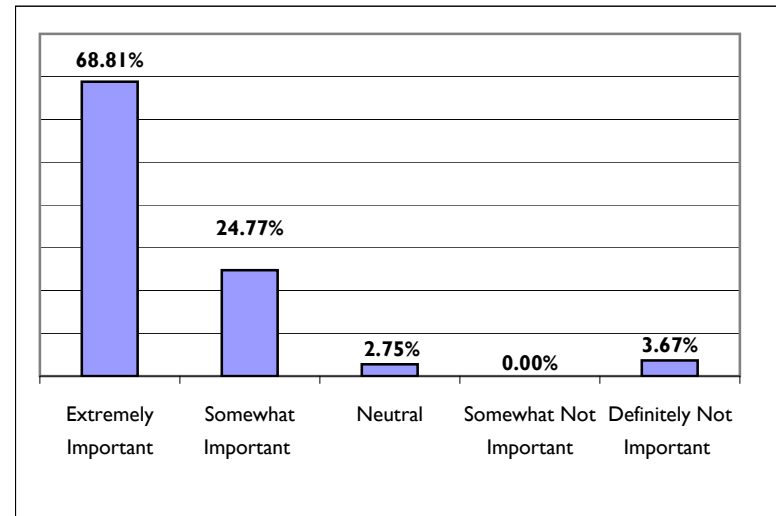

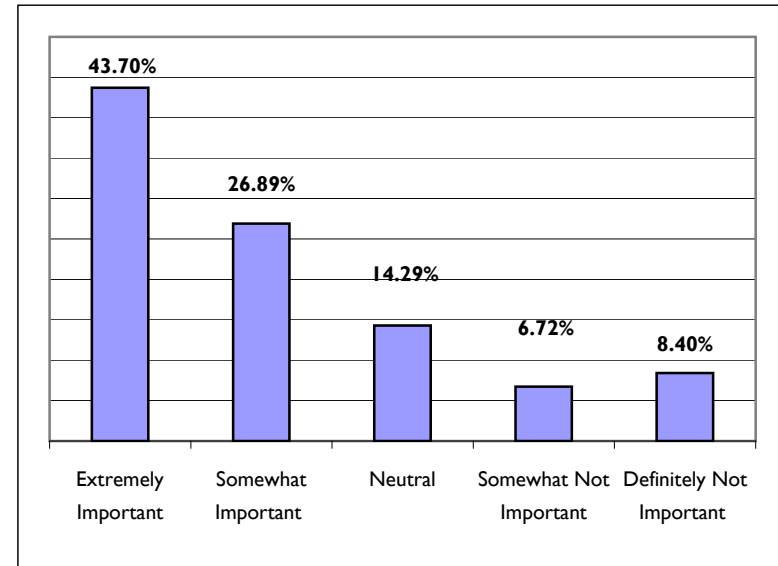

Goal #3: New construction and redevelopment are compatible with existing development.

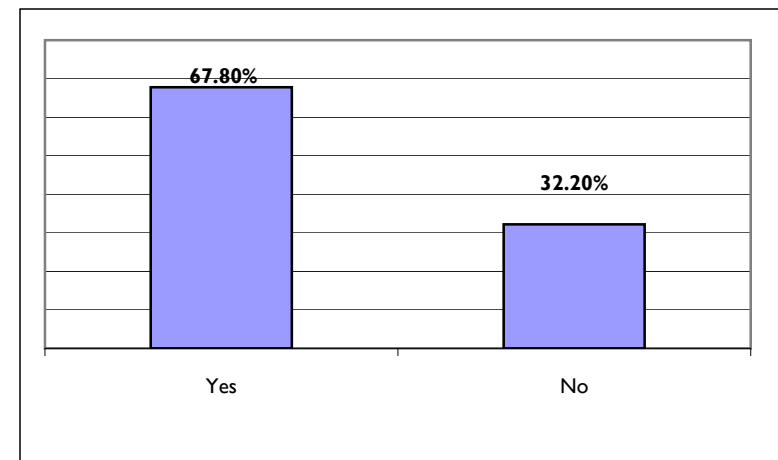
How important do you feel this is to the future of Cincinnati?

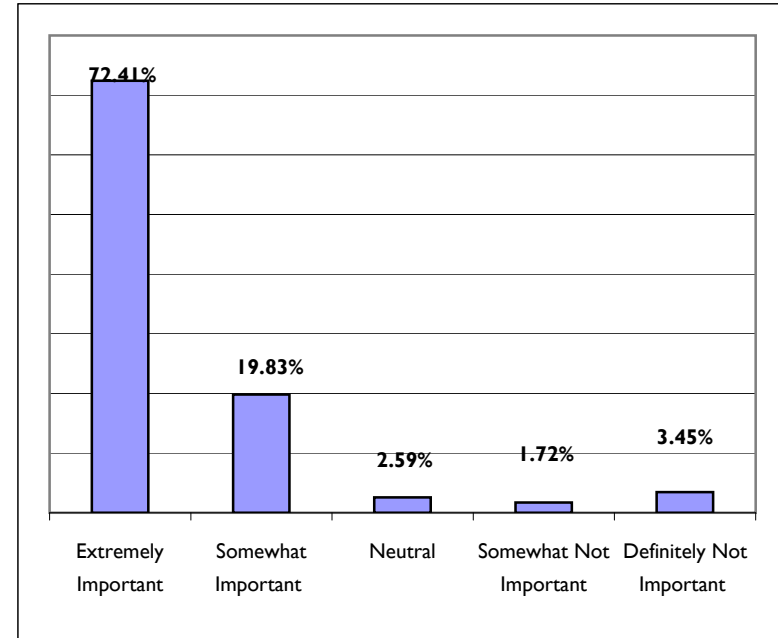

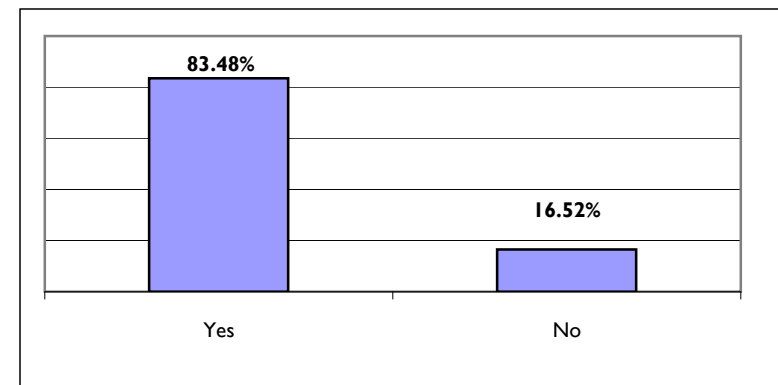
*How important do you feel this is to the future of Cincinnati?

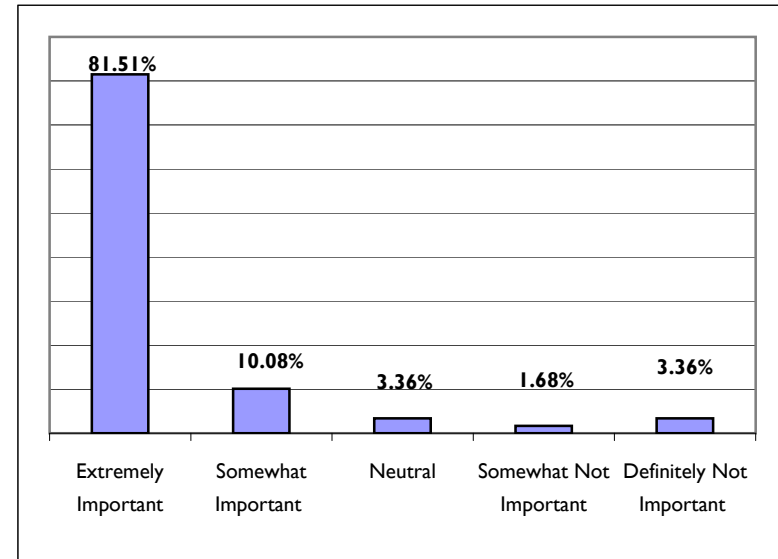

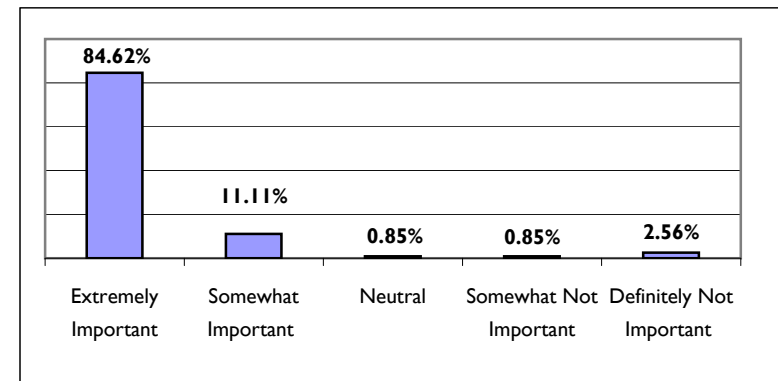

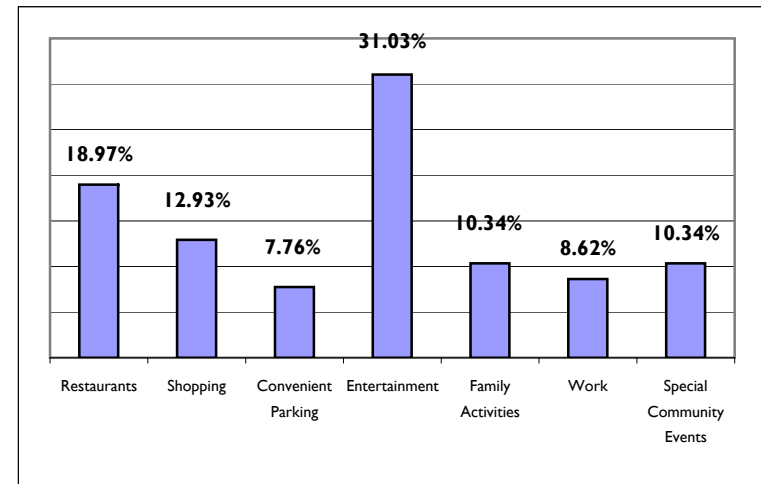

Critical Question: What would most influence you to come to Cincinnati NBDs and Downtown?

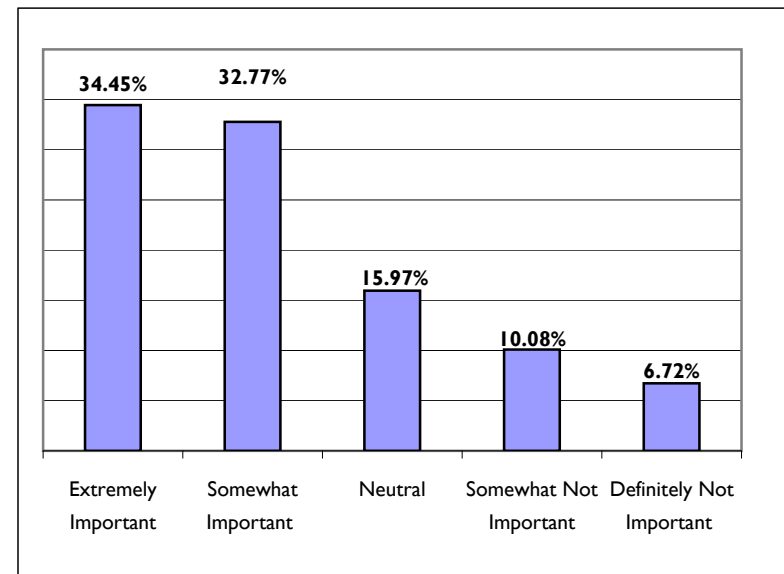
