Description:

The Advanced Technology and Learning Center Building was constructed in 2003. The building is connected to the Main Building via a two story connector bridge located at the second and third floor on the east side of the building. This building is constructed using reinforced concrete columns and post-tensioned reinforced concrete beams and slabs. The exterior is comprised of brick and masonry block, stone, insulated metal panel, as well as curtain wall systems at the student lounge, and the primary and secondary entrances. The building contains a book store, instructional kitchens, locker rooms, shipping and receiving docks, racquetball courts, classrooms, a demonstration kitchen, student and faculty lounges, meeting and conference rooms, a servery and deli, a production kitchen, a game and multi-purpose room, an auditorium, reading rooms, pastry kitchens, a restaurant, computer labs, an audio studio with mixing rooms, a video studio, storage, and support spaces.

Description:

The Health Professions Building at the Clifton Campus of Cincinnati State has a building footprint of 14,000 square feet. The building is connected to the Main Building via a two story connector bridge located at the first and second floor on the west side of the building. This building is conventionally framed with wide flange columns, wide flange joist and girder beam framing. The exterior is comprised of brick and masonry block with curtain wall systems at the primary and secondary entrances. Within the walls are found classrooms, labs, an auditorium, offices, storage, and support spaces.
